I William Garrett of Willistown in the County of Chester in Pennsylvania being in good health of Body and of a Sound disposing mind and memory praised be the Lord for the same and for all his other <u>Mercies</u> and <u>favours</u> and considering the certainty of death and the uncertainty of the time thereof, do make this my last Will and Testament as follows - - - -

Impremes My Will and Mind is that all my just debts and funeral charges expences be paid and satisfied by my Executors hereafter named as soon as may be after my deceas --

Item I Will to my son William and to his Heirs and Assigns forever Fifty Acres of Land be the same more or less adjoining and being the remainder of my Land I some time since conveyed to him – I also give my son William my Couch and Cloathspress – **Item** I Will and devise to my Son Thomas the Sum of five shillings and to my son Lewis the sum of five shillings to be eaised and levied out of my Estate by my Executor – **Item** I Will and bequeath all my wearing <u>apperal</u> to be equally devided between my sons Thomas and William – And all the rest residue and remainder of my Estate whether Real or personal of what kind soever or where ever the same may be I give and devise and bequeath all my daughters or <u>theire</u> Heirs to be equally <u>devided</u> between them – -

Lastly I do <u>nominate</u> and appoint my son William Garrett to be Executor of this my last Will & Testament and my Will and mind further is that my son William do at his own Cost Execute this my last Will without drawing any Commissions out of my Estate as is usual, in lieu of the extraordinary bequests made to him, and I do also Constitute and appoint my <u>frind</u> Isaac Massey to be Trustee of this my last Will and Testament hereby uterly reoking[sic] and disannulling all Wills by me heretofore made <u>declaring</u> this only to be my Last
